A Year's Overview

SUMMARY

In 2024, Rise Up Mission launched two impactful projects to reach out to communities suffering from the cycles of homelessness and drug addiction—one in San Diego, CA, and the other in Harlem, NY.

San Diego, CA

Our outreach efforts in San Diego focused on East Downtown, a critical area where many individuals are trapped in homelessness and addiction. After assessing the situation and training our team, we launched a structured outreach program:

- Two outreaches per week (Tuesdays & Thursdays)
- One “No Walls” church service every Saturday

Through these efforts, we reached 450 people with the Gospel of Christ, distributing hygiene kits and New Testament Bibles. Approximately 1% of those reached were transferred to rehabilitation programs, where they received logistical and transportation support to complete their recovery journey. We continuously pray for them, trusting that God will strengthen them to stay on their path to recovery.

A key part of our success was forming strong alliances with local partners, including Rescue Mission and San Diego Teen Challenge. We organized a Night of Prayer, bringing together our partners to present our vision and to work hand in hand.

Additionally, we conducted two revival camp services at rehabilitation camps, each hosting 400 people, for a total of 800. We were honored to collaborate with Pastor Frank Diaz and the United for All organization in Miami, FL, whose team traveled to San Diego in April 2024 to support the revival efforts.

Harlem, NY

In June 2024, God led us to expand our mission to Harlem, NY, in partnership with the Salvation Army Harlem. Every Tuesday, our team was deployed to minister to the community served by the Salvation Army.

- We shared the Gospel of Christ, distributed New Testament Bibles, and offered prayer and spiritual support.
- 85 people were led to Christ and connected to local churches, including Salvation Army Community Church and our home church, Times Square Church in New York.

Looking Ahead

To God be the glory! In 2024, Rise Up Mission reached over 500 people across San Diego and Harlem. As the Lord continues to lead us, we are preparing to expand our efforts to reach more communities—both in the U.S. and globally.
