### Poverty Level in Harlem NY

29% of residents in Central Harlem, New York lived below the federal poverty level. Central Harlem was the second-poorest neighborhood in Manhattan at the time.



### Number of people homeless in New York City NY

In July 2024, over 350,000 people were experiencing homelessness in New York City, [according to the Coalition for the Homeless](#). This is the highest number of homeless people in New York City since the Great Depression.



### More Data on the current state of NY

- New York State had more than 158,000 homeless people in 2024
- New York City accounted for 93% of the increase in the state's total homeless population
- New York's rate of homelessness was higher than all states except Hawaii and the District of Columbia
